STORING YOUR CHECKLIST - The inventory checklist should be placed in a safe spot. Remember its purpose. In case of a fire or catastrophic event, the inventory will do no good if it is burned up, or washed away with the rest of your possessions. Suggested places to store your inventory include: a safety deposit box that is fire proof and water proof, a trusted friend's house, a bank or file it with your insurance agent.

TAKE A PHOTO - It is recommended that you take photographs or a video of each room at least once a year and store them with the checklist.
